- ▶ The application packet must be submitted to the CRA by **December 4, 2009**.

Also note that regardless of "winning" status, all job nominations photos will be shown in the slide presentation throughout dinner).

ALL JOBS ARE JUDGED ON:

- ▶ **Creative Solutions to Roofing Problems** (i.e.: special or unique design, cost-saving innovations, etc.)
- ▶ **Workmanship/Difficulty of Installation** (i.e.: unusual/unfamiliar materials, complexity of job, multiple types of roofing systems installed, numerous steps/phases, coordination with other trades, etc.)
- ▶ **Specific Project Requirements** (i.e.: job conditions, site restrictions such as height, roof slope & access, special equipment, weather, deadlines, etc.)
- ▶ **Safety Procedures & Considerations** (i.e.: crew and/or public safety, safety plan, safety hazards and/or special considerations, use of special machinery, etc.).
